WHEREAS, the City Administration has recommended that Codified Ordinance Section 260.05(6) be amended to increase the annual uniform and clothing allowance for Dispatchers to \$375.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, to wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT Section 260.05(b) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (b) The City shall allot the following annual uniform and clothing allowance as follows:
