WHEREAS, the Director of Safety and Service has reviewed the classification plan, job titles and pay ranges for employees of the City of Wapakoneta whose positions are not covered under the provisions of the existing collective bargaining agreements, and

WHEREAS, Section 260.08 of the Codified Ordinances of Wapakoneta, Ohio states as follows, "The salary to be paid to all City employees shall be established by Council".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT the following job titles and pay range numbers are hereby established for positions within the City of Wapakoneta which are not covered by collective bargaining agreements:

*** Position qualifies for emergency medical technician (E.M.T.) certification stipend based on the following rates:

E.M.T. B (Bridge) =\$500/YR

E.M.T. I (Advanced) = \$1,000/YR

E.M.T. P (Paramedic) = \$1,500/YR

These incentives are not accumulative. Individuals will be compensated in accordance with his/her highest level certification and must maintain certification requirements of City's Medical Director.

**** Residential Building Official = \$500/YR

**** Residential Plans Examiner = \$500/YR

**** Residential Building Inspector = \$500/YR

**** Residential Plumbing Inspector = \$500/YR

**** Residential Safety Inspector = \$500/YR

Certifications are accumulative

SECTION TWO

THAT Chapter 260.17 of the "Codified Ordinance of the City of Wapakoneta" shall be amended as follows:

260.17 HOLIDAYS.

(a) All non-bargaining unit employees who are covered by this chapter shall receive the following recognized holidays off at their regular rate of pay:

New Year's Day	Thanksgiving
Memorial Day	Friday after Thanksgiving
Independence Day	Christmas
Labor Day	
Employee Birthday: Police Dispatchers and Administrative Assistant, Eng	
Manager, Office Manager, Electric Supt, Waste Water Supt, Water Supt, Public Works Supt,	
Police Chief, Fire Chief and Safety Service Dir.	

The holiday shall be considered the day on which the holiday is celebrated in the calendar year upon which it falls. Should the paid holiday fall on Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday or the following Monday shall be given off unless another date is agreed upon with the Director of Public Service and Safety.

b) Instead of seven paid holidays per year, the Police Department Dispatchers will have seven eight-hour shifts off per year at regular pay. In addition to the holidays herein

discussed, each Police Department Dispatcher will be given two additional personal-leave shift (sixteen hours) with pay each year. This personal-leave shift shall be scheduled in accordance with holiday scheduling policies and procedures established for the Department. The standard work day for Police Department Dispatchers is eight hours. Police Dispatchers who work during the hours of 0000 hours and 2400 hours on Thanksgiving and Christmas shall be paid at their overtime rate for all hours worked on these two specific holidays. This shall not apply to any hours worked by a police officer or lieutenant assigned to dispatch duties during these hours.

(c) Department heads in the Department of Public Service and Safety and the Administrative Assistant to the Director of Public Service and Safety shall be given two personal-leave day (sixteen hours) each year. Said personal-leave day shall be scheduled in accordance with the holiday scheduling policies and procedures established for the City.

(d) Short-term employees, such as summer help and those hired periodically for temporary work, are not eligible for holiday pay.

SECTION THREE

THAT the provisions of this ordinance shall be retroactively effective at 12:01 A.M. on Jan 1, 2012. Any city legislation or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance, are hereby repeated

SECTION FOUR

THAT this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, it being for the protection, safety and welfare of the citizens of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and for the further reason that said wage adjustments shall be retroactively effective on Jan 1, 2012; so, therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
