BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT the Director of Public Safety and Service be and he is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for certain materials, services, and equipment rental needed for the operation of various departments of the City of Wapakoneta.

SECTION TWO

THAT the aforesaid contracts shall be for a period of not to exceed one (1) year or for immediate purchase and shall be in accordance with specifications on file in the office of said director. Bid items will be: ferrous chloride, electrical wire, meter testing, transformers and electrical supplies, asphalt paving, water treatment salt, road salt, lime, kiln dust, water meters, fire hydrants, equipment rental, refuse bags, cast-in-place concrete construction, gasoline and diesel fuel, sewer pipe, waterline and waterline fittings, crushed stone, sand, slurry sealing, full-depth reclamation (F.D.R.), tree trimming and stump removal services.

SECTION THREE

THAT this ordinance shall be in force from and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


