Motion by Sheipline, second by Campbell to approve the minutes of the February 17, 2025 council meeting as submitted. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.

President Pro Tem Miller asked Clerk to read Ord 2025-07 for the third time re: AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 13093 INFIRMARY ROAD, WAPAKONETA, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO.

Motion by Dunlap, second by Greve to adopt Ord 2025-07. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.

President Pro Tem Miller asked Clerk to read Res 2025-09 for the third time re: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF CITY PROPERTY THROUGH INTERNET AUCTION.

Motion by Campbell, second by Sheipline to adopt Res 2025-09. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.

President Pro Tem Miller asked Clerk to read Ord 2025-11 for the third time re: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion by Dunlap, second by Greve to adopt Ord 2025-11. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.

President Pro Tem Miller asked Clerk to read Ord 2025-14 for the first time re: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO PURCHASE DUCTILE IRON UTILITY POLES FROM MCWANE POLES WITHOUT THE TAKING OF BIDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SSD Price explained that emergency language is due to long lead times for ordering. He added that McWane is the only company in the US that manufactures such poles.

Motion by Campbell, second by Sheipline to suspend the rules for Ord 2025-14. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.

Motion by Greve, second by Campbell to adopt Ord 2025-14. Vote – 7 yeas, 0 nays. Motion passed.
